



## Solution Up'n Turn

*How can you open and close a basic flow pack fitting fragile products, without damaging it and without tearing up the packaging?*

### Solution

With this system, you can open a pack containing the piled products, and to reclose this pack by adapting the volume to the remaining contents. No risk to tear up the packaging.

The opening is very wide and permits to pick up the products through one extremity, when the flow pack is really tight fitted.

### Applications

- Agrifood industry and others
- Piled products in a very tight fitted flow pack
- Particularly adapted to cheap flow packs

### Functionalities

- Convenient packaging
- Preservation of the content
- Easy picking and reclosing
- No risk of tearing the pack, despite the wide opening
